Antelope Valley Conservancy is seeking biology and ecology professionals for species monitoring and planning services, for fiscal 2012-2013. **What to Submit:** Respondents should provide full contact information, description of their services, training, and summary of relevant experience.

Preserve Workers – Preserve Stewardship/Restoration

February 24, 2012. Antelope Valley Conservancy is compiling a list of interested persons for preserve stewardship and restoration work. **Some work is offered on a volunteer basis; some work is paid employment.** Work involves plants, plant materials, soil, rocks, use of tools, bending, carrying of up to 50 pounds, and other activities associated with landscaping. Work is part-time, scheduled by mutual agreement, however, some full days are required due to the remote location of habitat properties.

Requirements: (1) Applicants should be able to perform the above described work; (2) be able to walk long distances; (3) be able to perform physical labor in a sun drenched desert climate; (4) have reliable transportation; and (5) have an interest in the ecology of the Antelope Valley Conservancy's service area (see web site for information). **What to Submit:** Respondents should provide their full contact information, and describe: their work history, relevant coursework, interests, career goals, and availability.
